1. Elica's molded-glass Star Cooker island hood can be operated using a remote control or the touch-sensitive rod at its base. (Priced upon request; elica.com) 2. Zephyr's 36" Horizon hood is available with a black-, white-, or red-glass finish—and with an etched design. (Approx. \$2,500; available spring 2008; zephyronline.com) 3. Fuego's Modular outdoor kitchen system allows you to add components—including a grill, warming drawer, storage unit, or sink—to fit your needs. (Priced upon request; fuegoliving.com) 4. The LI700x dishwasher from Ariston

uses less than four gallons of water per wash. (\$1,249; www.aristonappliances.us) 5. IKEA's BOHOLMEN sink comes without a precut faucet hole. (\$131; IKEA.com) You can use the store's FIXA tool (only \$7.99) to cut the hole wherever you want it. 6. The horizontal design of bulthaup's four-burner cooktop by Foster means you'll never have to reach over a flame. It can be installed in a 43" model, where the knobs are placed in your cabinet fronts (shown above), or a 47" version, with knobs on the cooktop. (\$3,878–\$5,528; bulthaup.com)@
